June may be your last chance to sow seeds of herbs such as coriander, basil, chervil, fennel, dill, and parsley before the weather becomes too warm for them to germinate reliably.

June is an excellent month to pick out a few new perennials and plant them in the garden.

Oregon on average has approximately 125 days between the last and first frost. The last frost is stated to occur on April 26th according to the USDA. Oregon is in USDA plant hardiness zones 5-9. So, if you are looking for specific planting dates, make sure to use the zones above as reference.
